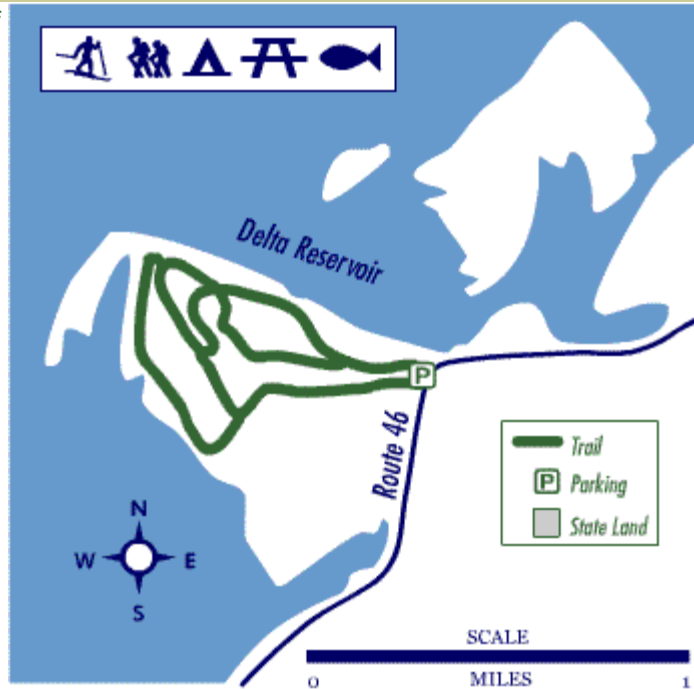




## Delta Lake State Park Cross-Country Ski Trails & Hiking Trails

Delta Lake State Park is located in the Town of Western in Oneida County, 6 miles northeast of Rome. There are approximately 3 miles of marked and groomed cross-country ski trails in the winter, which are also used for hiking during the summer months. There is no fee charged to use these trails. The trails are for the novice to intermediate skier. The trail system is a series of loops that allow the skier or hiker to follow a route of their preferred distance. Delta Lake State Park also offers a variety of other recreational activities. Because of its location to the reservoir and its unique landform, there is a great amount of water frontage, and many of the activities available are water related. These activities include swimming, fishing, and boating with a boat launch facility available in the park during the summer months and ice fishing in the winter. Other activities include camping and picnicking, with a food concession open during the summer.



**Directions:** To get to Delta Lake State Park from the south, take Route 46 north out of Rome for approximately 6 miles. The entrance to the park will be on the left side of the road.
