



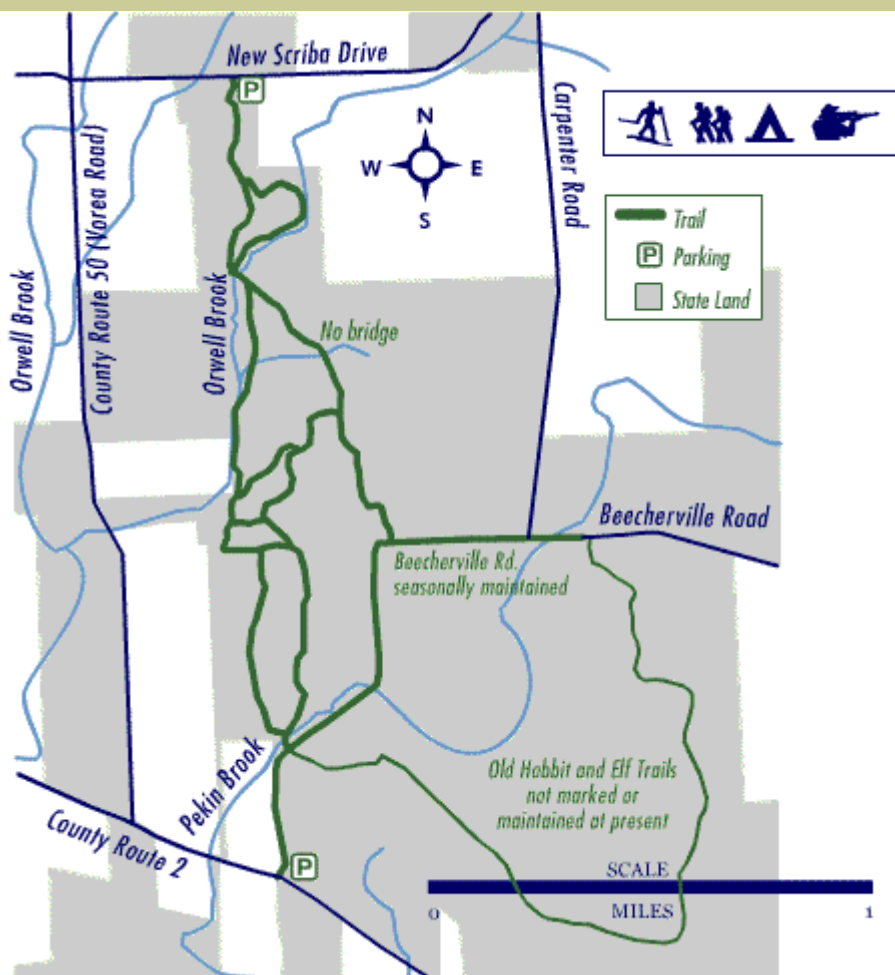
Chateaugay State Forest Cross-Country Ski Trails & Hiking Trails

Chateaugay State Forest is located approximately 7.5 miles east of Pulaski, in the Town of Orwell, Oswego County. In 1978-79 the Oswego County Conservation Corps and the Youth Conservation Corps cut and marked a network of trails through the forest. There are approximately 7 miles of marked forest trails with an additional 8 miles of unplowed, unmarked roads. The trails have been designed for the moderate to expert skier. These trails are also excellent for hiking.

Directions: To get to Chateaugay State Forest, take I-81 to the Pulaski exit. Take Co. Rt. 2 (Pulaski-Redfield Road) east through Richland and Orwell. Beecherville Road intersects Co. Rt. 2 from the north 1.9 miles east of Orwell.
